

ESSENTIAL SUMMER CAMP INFO

What time do I drop my child off?

Check-in day is on Sunday

Red Brush 2:00pm - 3:15 pm 1st - 6th grade campers

InPursuit & TST 3:15pm - 4:30pm 6th - 12th grade campers

*Wed. July 29th Jr. Explores (Session 2) check-in is at 2:00pm

Camper release: On opening day you or the adult who brings your child is required to list everyone authorized to pick up your child on closing day. These are the only individuals permitted to complete the check-out process (**picture ID required**) and pick up your child. This process is required by State Law for your child's protection.

How do I communicate with my camper while they are at camp?

In Writing: Mail is a highlight of a camper's week and is distributed daily. If you would like to bring mail on opening day, we will distribute it on the day or day's you designate. Or, if you prefer to send mail, please include the following information in the mailing address:

NOTE: Please do not bring candy or food on opening day or send it through the mail, as campers are not allowed to have perishable items in their cabins.

Email: You will be able to email your camper only while they are at camp. You will be given instructions on how to email through the "Parent Zone" on our website when you check-in for camp. Campers cannot email back.

How do I contact camp in case of emergency?

What if my child requires a special diet or has food allergies?

Our kitchen is familiar with special diets and food allergies. Please notify our camp office and we will make proper arrangements in order to provide the best experience for your child.

How much spending money should I put in my camper's account?

The Trading Post is open during check in and closing day for parents and visitors. Each camper will visit the Trading Post daily. Snacks and drinks are available for your camper to purchase, along with many low cost souvenir items (\$1-\$7) Typical spending is approximately \$20-\$30.

Is a physician visit necessary to complete my child's health care form?

No. You will need to complete the campers Health Form /Power of Attorney at the Parent Zone online at www.springhillcamps.com the week before your camper attends camp. If you do not have access to our website, please contact us and we will mail you these forms.

What does my child need to pack for camp?

- Pajamas, underwear and extra socks
- Warm jacket, hat and raincoat
- Modest one-piece swimsuit, beach towel and sunscreen
- Two pairs of shoes (one that can get wet and one closed toe)
- Towel, washcloth, toiletries and comb or brush
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Flashlight
- Small backpack
- Bible, notebook and pen
- Long pants
- Disposable camera (optional)
- Bug spray with DEET
- A desire to have FUN!

What NOT to pack:

 Please do not pack any of the following items:

- Food
- Valuables
- Vitamins
- Non-prescription or over the counter medications
- Spending money (Bring to opening day check-in.)
- Radios, CD players, gaming devices, iPods or other MP3 players
- Cell phones or pagers

What time do I pick my child up?

Check-out day is on Friday.

Camper check-outs and closing events will begin promptly at the following times.

Special items for major programs: SpringHill provides safety gear and equipment for most programs, although although campers are welcome to bring their own. For certain programs, campers may need to bring special equipment or apparel, including the following:
